 Sid won't eat because the National hasn't called.

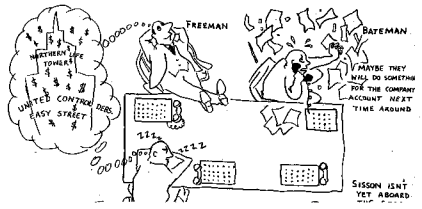

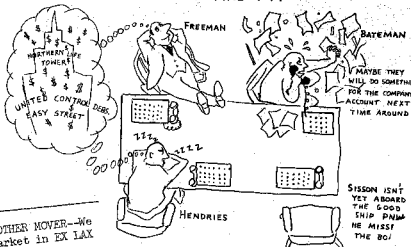
